

- Have you ever witnessed a crime?

If the answer is yes, then you should contact Crimestoppers.

Crimestoppers is an anonymous service which allows you to report crimes via email and Type -Talk.

Type -Talk calls and emails will not be traced and your anonymity is guaranteed.

As Crimestoppers is not part of the police you will not be required as a witness and not be asked to appear in court, you may even be entitled to a reward.
